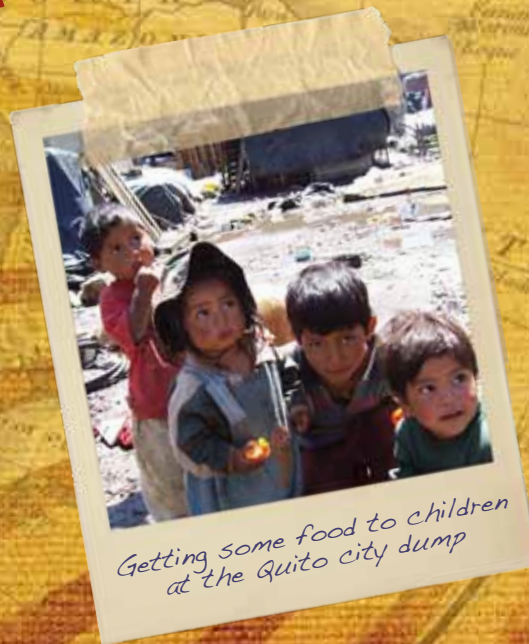

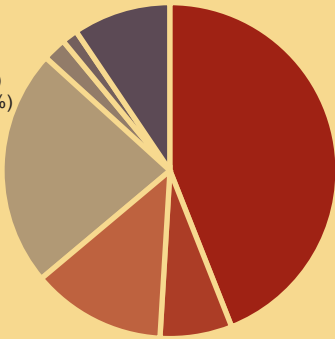
Financial Support

We believe it is a miracle that people willingly and joyfully send financial support for us as missionaries, month in and month out, and hopefully over many years. But our goal is to build long-term relationships that are satisfying for you and us. God will accomplish great things through your kind heart and giving.

The charts below outline the committed monthly support necessary to do this ministry.

Living Expenses: \$1,690 (our monthly paycheck)

- Housing (43%)
- Utilities (7%)
- Technology (13%)
- Food & Supply (23%)
- Professional Svc. (2%)
- Insurance (2%)
- Emergency (10%)



Other Expenses: \$2,510 (ER delegated monthly)

- Medical Ins. (23%)
- Tuition (33%)
- Project Fees (12%)
- Furlough (8%)
- Retirement (8%)
- Administration (16%)

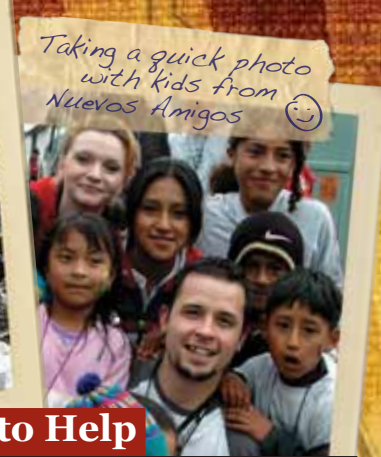


TOTAL SUPPORT NEEDED: (\$4,200)

We will also need to build up funds for the **One-Time Expenses** associated with making this move. Those expenses include: Language School; Missions Training; Relocation and Travel to School/Training/Field; Purchase of Vehicle, Furnishings, Appliances, Electronics, Home Necessities, Etc. These One-Time Expenses will total approximately **\$41,000.**
